

A Weary World Rejoices Advent 2022

Advent marks the dawn of a new church year. The word "advent" means "coming" and denotes the four-week period before Christmas when the church remembers Jesus' first coming and looks forward to his return.

Advent celebrates the mystery of God's incarnation in the person of Jesus Christ when, in the words of John's Gospel, "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.

The mood of Advent is that of longing, of expectation, and of waiting. Advent is a time when we yearn for Jesus as the world's anointed King to come back and make all things new. The cry of Advent is the cry of those who have experienced the tyranny of sin and injustice in a world under the curse, and yet who have hope in a God who hears their cries. It is a time of repentance and faith as we prepare for God to fully reorder His creation and redeem His people. We join the Apostle John in praying, "Come, Lord Jesus" (Revelation 22:20).

We have put together the following Advent guide to help you as individuals, small groups, and families to enter into the story of the Gospel in new and deep ways, remembering His faithfulness, clinging to His promises, turning from sin and yearning for His return. We hope that the Scripture readings, prayers, and hymns will lead you to great hope in the Lord.

May Christ grant us all a blessed Advent and Christmas!

A Daily Advent Meditation

- * Take a moment to consider who Christ is and who you are before him. Pray, "Come, Lord Jesus."
- * Meditate on the day's Scripture Lesson.
- * Respond to the Lesson with your own prayer, confessing sin and expressing longing for the Lord.
- * Sing a Hymn of Advent
- * Close in prayer, using one of the Psalms for Advent.
